# Our Competitions to recommence on June 27th

#### From The Committee

What a difference a couple of months makes!!! We have filled out all the appropriate paper work and are set to run a competition in June, Hooray. Entries will be up on Nominate shortly. It will run a little differently to our normal competitions to minimize the amount of time on the ground and encourage good social distancing.

Competitors will only be able to enter a level and ride the two tests at that level. This way most tests can be scheduled back to back. Competitors will be able to arrive, ride their two tests and leave thereby minimizing the amount of time on the ground.

- We will have to limit it to 40 riders on the day so the event will be filled on a first come first served bases.
- No Spectators or non-competing riders (ie bringing your horse out for familiarization)
- You will be able to bring one support person but they must be nominated on the entry form with contact info.
- All signing in will be done electronically either via the live scoring app or text to the office.
- Tests will be emailed out to you as per usual.
- There will be no presentation or collection of rosettes.
- There will be no catering.


