Others brought out their young horses for a low key look and see. We will be holding another one of these on January 30th in conjunction with the Training Day planned for that day. This will however mean that there will only be arena time slots to book into.

February 27 is our Dawn and Dusk completion and is once again a full moon. We thought we would shake up the schedule a bit and run some



different classes in the Dawn and Dusk especially since we weren't able to run our Dec12 comp. Entries will be out early in the new year.

For members joining MCDC before 31/12/20 we are offering free entry into the 2021 Annual Performance Awards. Membership renewals have been sent with an easy to use link. Please ensure that you enter the Awards by 31/12/20 to get your free entry.

Upgrading of Horses

We would like to congratulate the following riders for their performances. Mt Crawford has an upgrading policy for our restricted classes. Upgrade of Horses occurs when:

- Combinations with 5 wins of 65% or above in Preparatory tests are asked to upgrade to Preliminary or ride HC.
- Combinations with 5 wins of 65% or above in Preliminary tests are asked to upgrade to Novice or compete HC.
- Combinations with 5 wins of 65% or above at Novice level are asked to upgrade to Elementary or compete HC.
- Combinations with 5 wins of 65% or above at Elementary level are asked to upgrade to Medium or ride HC.

Combinations are welcome to ride at a higher level at any time, regardless of whether they need to upgrade or not. EA graded horses may compete in restricted classes at their graded level or higher, unless pointed out as per the above. You can find the full policy on our website.
