# Entry Requirements for Club Champs

If you don't fulfill these requirements, you can still ride on the day but you will not be eligible for the Championship.

- You must be a MCDC member, new members must be a member of the MCDC before the 1st Janauary 2022 & the horse must have competed previously at a MCDC competition.
- If a horse is graded at one level, it cannot be ridden at the club championships in a lower level. You can however, ride up a level.
- Riders are expected to compete at the level they have been riding at for the majority of competitions throughout the previous year or higher. In the case of equality, the rider must choose one level to ride at.
- CUR combinations entries must not have competed competitively in previous 12 months.



<sup>\*</sup> If class size is greater than 3 riders. Classes with less than three riders may be combined.

#### **Training Days**

We have had some interesting and varied Training Days in the second half of the year. The September Training Day with Greg Trembath offered a new option for riders to have a Groundwork lesson as well as regular ridden lessons. Six members took advantage of the groundwork lessons offered and used this as an opportunity to get their youngsters out and about as well as brushing up on skills for the more seasoned riders. We also had another two new members join the club to come to the training day, so it's great to see new faces attending and we hope to see them coming to the competition days as well. Between showers of rain, it was a great day and we had positive feedback from both the ridden and groundwork lessons.

The October Training Day was with Naomi Mashford and Tracy Whiter and it was a little bit different to our normal days as they worked in conjunction with each other and were focusing on the horse's biomechanics. The instructors were looking at how to help achieve freedom in movement and assist with the horse's strengths and weaknesses from a biomechanical perspective. It was a cool, cloudy day, but perfect for riding with no rain or wind. Many of the riders commented that they got a great deal of interesting information out of the day and learnt the areas to work on to help their horses move correctly and address any weaknesses.



We had Lucy Williams instructing on the 20th November and as expected, this Training Day sold out very quickly and was enjoyed by all those that attended despite the weather leading up to it. We finished the year off with a Dressage Test Critique Day on the 4th December and were fortunate enough to have qualified judges Carly Boon and Phoebe Foulkes critiquing. The day allowed members to ride a test and get direct feedback from the judge straight after they ride. Riders then had the opportunity to practice their movements and then ride again in front of the judge to see how their scores improved.

Our first training day back will be on Jan 22 with Greg Trembath. On Feb 26 we will be having Anne Smith. We are hoping to have the every popular Lucy Williams back in March with Phoebe Foukles on April 23rd round out the first quarter of 2022.

#### **Thorough Care SA OTT Dressage Series**






